



Scope of Work for DRYWALL Contractor

1. Contractor shall provide and keep up to date Workman's Comp (or State exemption) and Liability Insurance.
2. Trade shall provide a 1 - year warranty on all work.
3. Contractor will install any dead wood needed or have Habitat employee do so prior to hanging drywall.
4. Contractor will make sure all plugs and rough-in boxes are exposed.
5. All Drywall scraps in Dumpster or piled in yard if there is no dumpster.
6. Pricing shall be locked in and not changed unless consulted with Construction Manager.
7. Contractor shall be responsible for any and all damage on sites and immediately inform a Knoxville Habitat employee of any occurrences.
8. Any additional charges are discussed up front prior to any work done.
9. Contractor will protect any adjacent lots or properties from trash or damage.
10. Contractor will not block any street or driveway.
11. Contractor will not play loud music and refrain from obscene or bad language.
12. Streets and job sites will be kept CLEAN.
